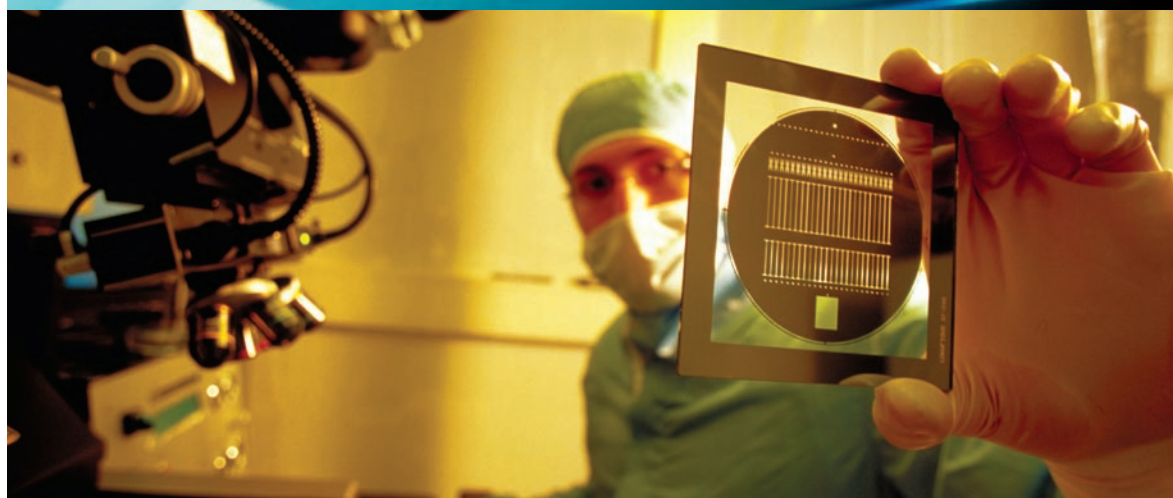

The aim of this event is to encourage confidential meetings between technology developers and technology users in order to foster technical cooperation in the field of micro & nanotechnology. It is not only open to exhibitors but also to visitors.

The brokerage event is the place to meet technological partners in the heart of an industrial and highly specialised trade fair. In 2008, several clusters will be present.

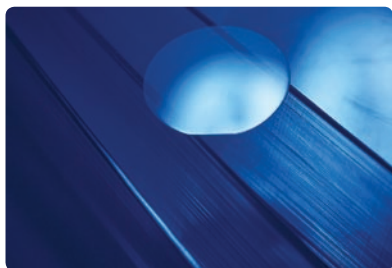

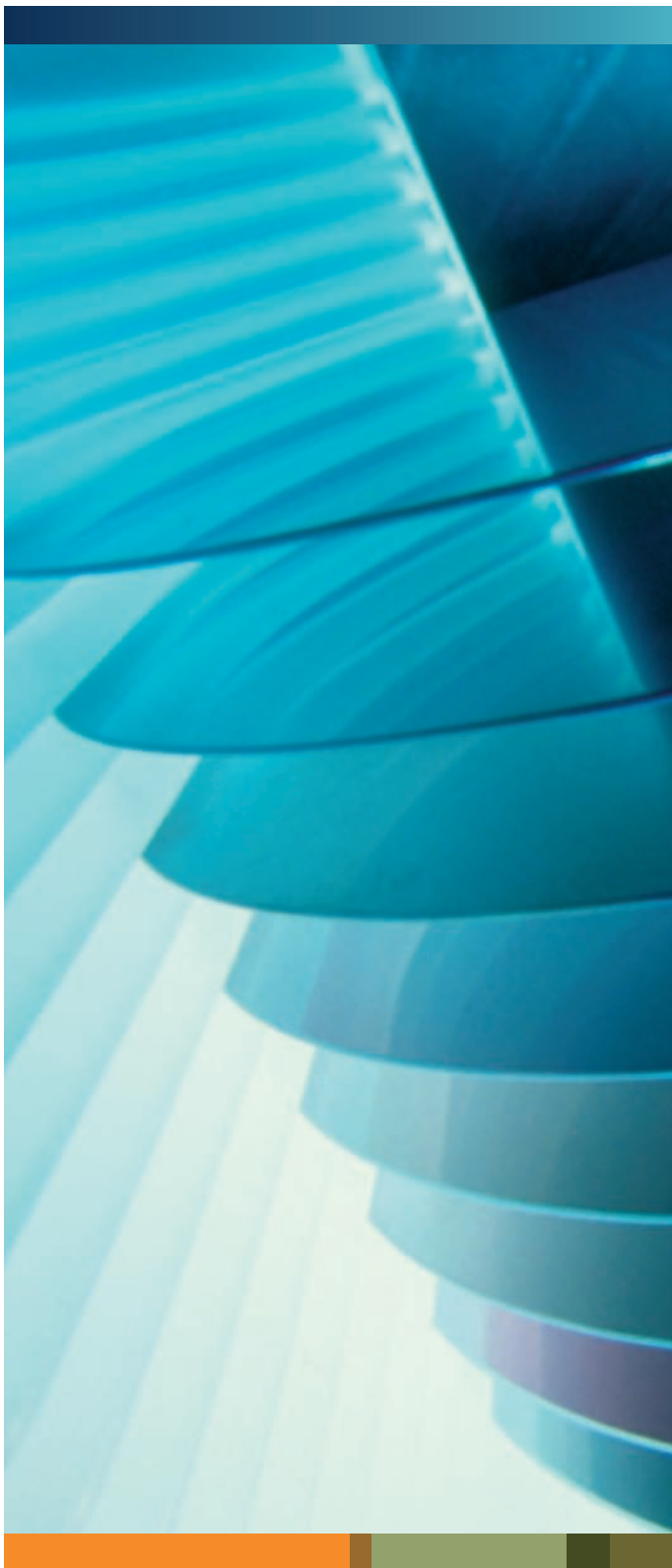
